Covid 19 Screening Questionnaire

If you have any of these, we ask you reschedule your appointment.

Do you have symptoms of illness?

A cough, fever over 100.4 F, shortness of breath, diarrhea, muscle aches, unusual fatigue, sore throat or runny nose, loss of taste or smell, chills: contact your primary care provider to see if you should be tested for COVID 19. Do not come to office, we will reschedule your appointment for when you are well.

Have you travelled or been in contact with a person who has traveled to these countries or places, within 2 weeks?

Travel outside the US or in an area of the US where there is a high infection rate within the last two weeks? (I.e. China, Europe, Iran, Ireland, Malaysia, UK, NYC, San Francisco, Seattle, Portland, Atlanta, New Orleans, etc.)

Have you been in close contact with a person confirmed with Covid 19 infections?

- Within 72 h (3 days) before symptoms started
- Within 7 days after symptoms began
- With 3 days after symptoms ended

Have you been told by a public health official that you might have been exposed to someone with Covid 19?

Please let us know. You may need to be rescheduled. We recognize that this may be inconvenient but are trying to keep you and our other patients safe and healthy.

Covid 19 Precautions at GSPRS

What we ask of you:

Wait in your car and call us on the phone to let us know you are here. One of the staff will come out and take your temperature and pick up any papers you have for us. We ask you remain in your vehicle until time to go back to the exam room.

We prefer only you come into the office. However, if necessary, **ONE person** maximum, may accompany you to the office/exam/procedure room. They will need their temperature taken as well.

There will be no one sitting in the reception/waiting area. If you have to come up to the window in the office, please return to your vehicle after the communication is made. The rest room in the reception area will be open for your use if necessary.

We ask you to wear a mask at all times until it is necessary to remove for your exam/procedure.

What we are doing:

All staff will have their temperature taken daily and recorded; they will also monitor their family's temperature.

All staff, including surgeon, will wear street clothes into the office, change to their uniform scrubs for use during the day, and change out and wash their uniforms in the office daily.

All staff will wear a mask in the office when contacting patients and each other.

Front office will wear masks, gloves and eyewear when interacting with you.

Clinical staff will wear protective clothing, masks, disposable gloves and eye protection when taking care of you.

Each exam room will be extensively cleaned between patients.
